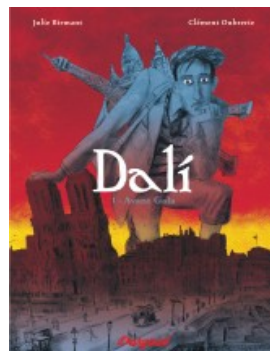
“I love Gala more than my mother, more than my father, more than Picasso, and even more than money.”
