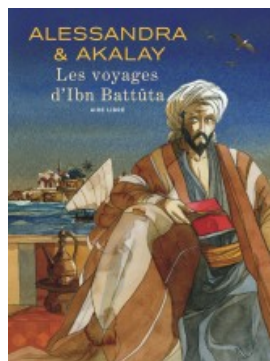

Ibn Battuta is the Marco Polo of the East.

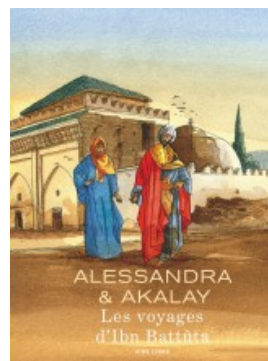
